Changes to the Hive

Due to an increase in demand for the Hive we will be setting up a third room. Breakfast club will remain the same; all nursery children, Reception and Year 1 will remain in the Purple Room. The Canteen will remain as the base for older children (Years 2-6).

All nursery and Preschool children will be based daily in the Purple Room.

Reception children on Mondays and Fridays will be in Purple Room and on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays will be based in the Reception classroom.

Years 1 and 2 will be based in the Year 2 classroom Monday to Thursday and will be in the canteen on a Friday.

We will display this information on the notice board by the internal gate in September as a reminder.
