





RECEPTION OUR LEARNING SPRING 2 WEEK 4



On the creative table, linked to the story of Zog and the Flying Doctors, we used clay to create dragon eyes. The children used their fine and gross motor skills to manipulate the clay into an eye shape. The children then placed their dragon eye pupils in the centre, created a roll of clay to encase around the eye using crosshatching and slip to attach it. They then used clay tools to create scales around the eyes.

We have looked at the similarities and differences between castles and houses. The children enjoyed talking about the differences they saw and whether they would enjoy living in a castle.

In Music we read the story of Peter and the Wolf and then listened to the music that was used throughout the story to represent characters and what was happening in the story at that moment in time.
