Last week we really enjoyed activities based on the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

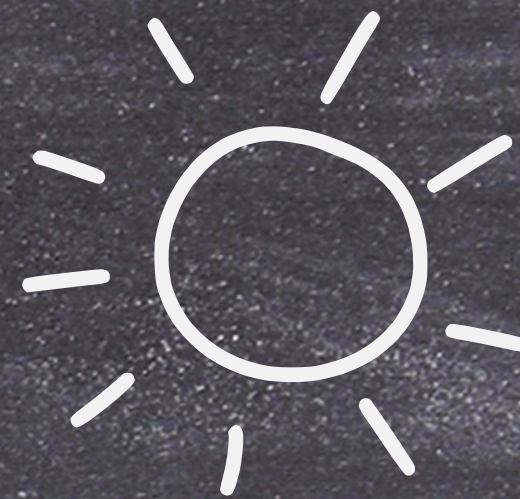

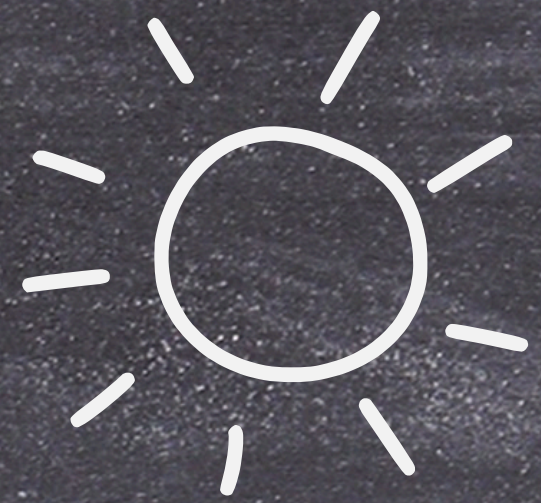
