How is this the last week of the school year? What a truly wonderful year it's been.

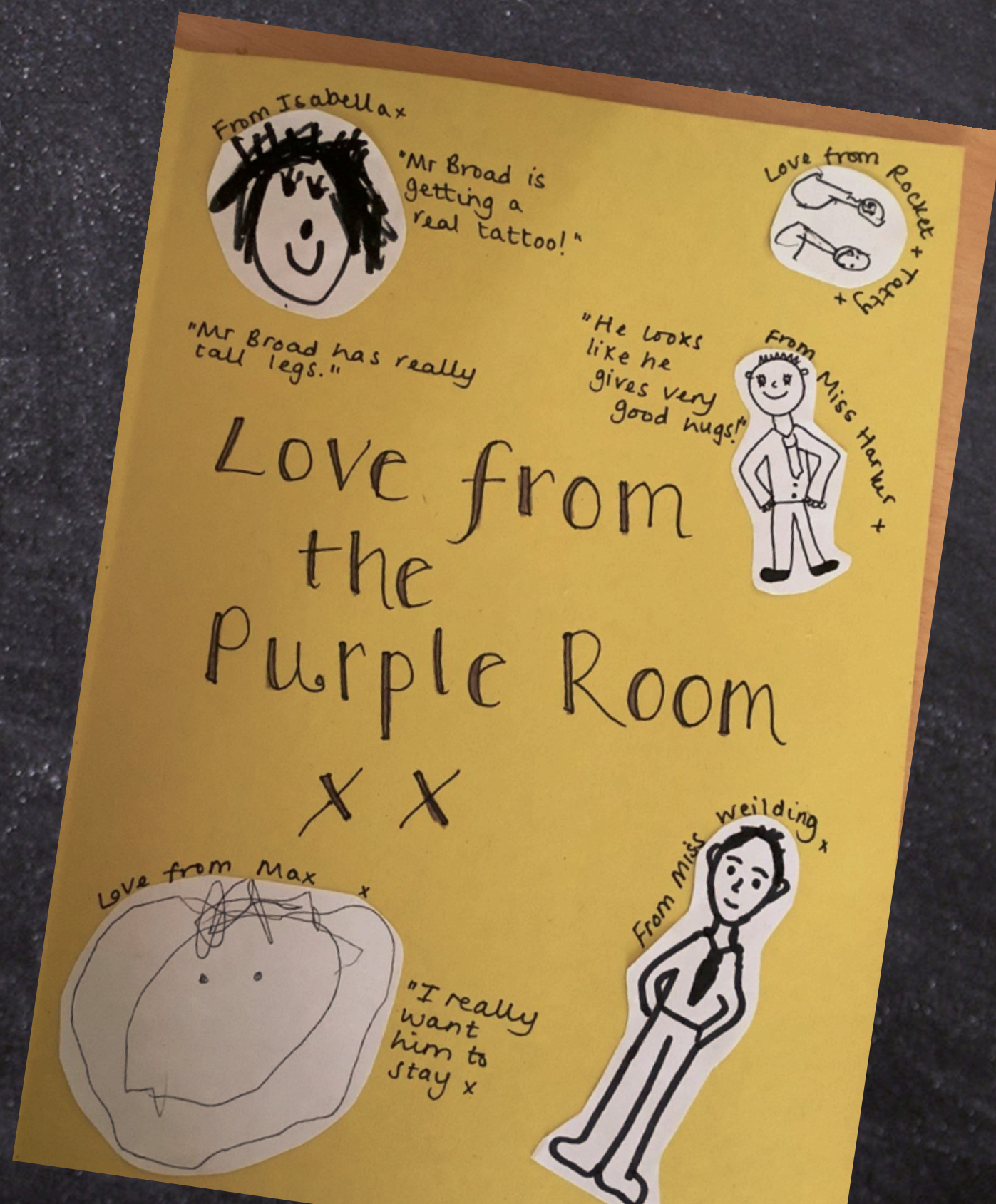
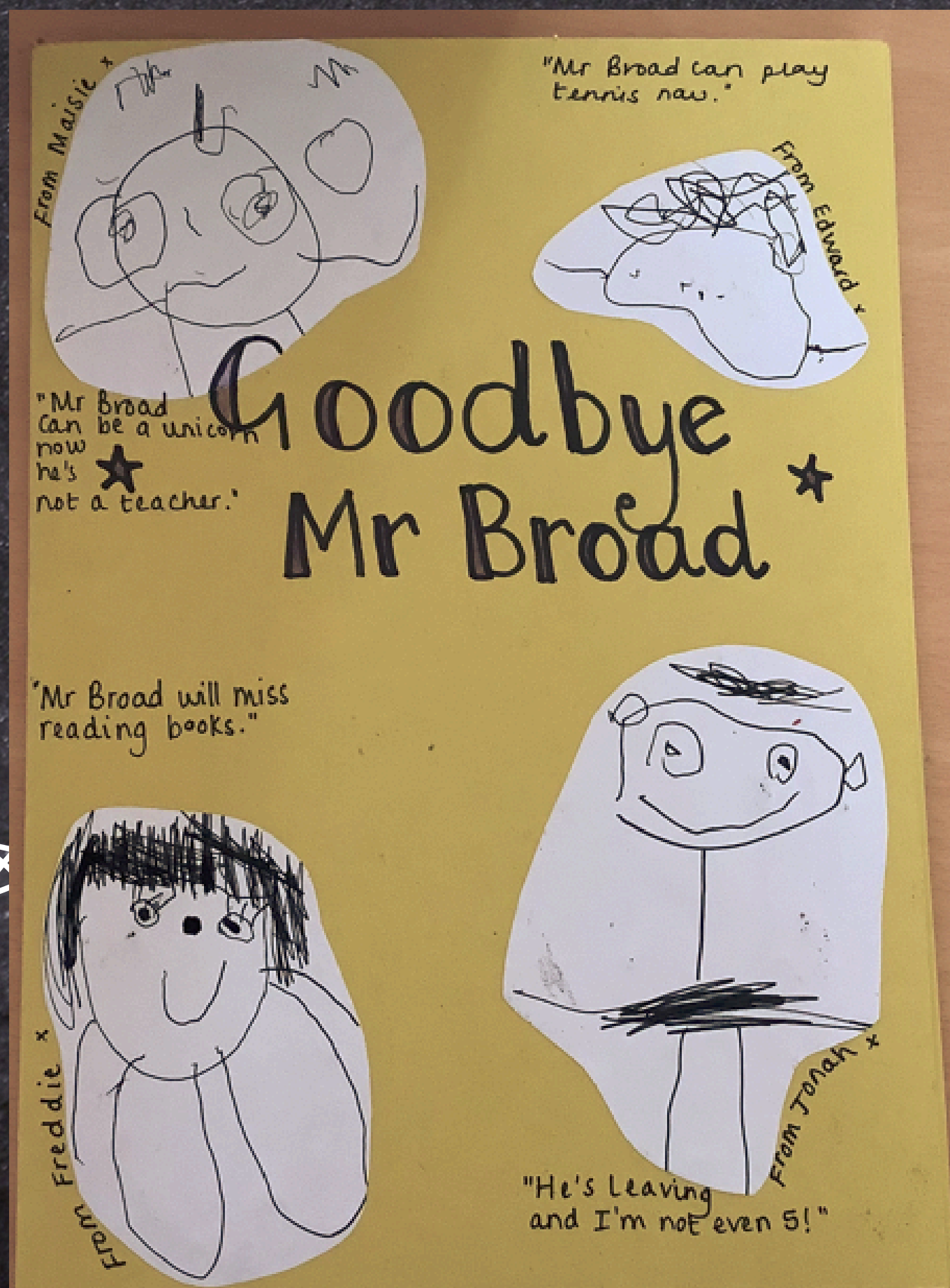
