Authorised and unauthorised absence

There can sometimes be confusion over when an absence can be authorised. As a general rule, an unexplained absence will always be unauthorised. If a pupil is absent when the register is taken, and we haven't been informed in advance by a parent/carer, a phone call will be made to parents/carers to explore the reason for the absence. If we are unable to get through to the parent/carer by 12.00 midday, school staff may conduct a home visit as a safeguarding measure.

If a pupil does not attend school due to a factor relating to the parent/carer, rather than the child, then the absence will be unauthorised. For example, if a parent/carer can't get a child to school due to a mechanical breakdown on their vehicle, the absence will still be unauthorised.

If a parent/carer takes a pupil on holiday during term time, this absence will always be unauthorised.





Taster sessions are being held over the summer on


