The children have had a really lovely week and are settled into their new classes and are successfully building relationships with their new class teachers and friends.



Dear Mr Broad,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing on behalf of the British Red Cross to express our deepest gratitude and to celebrate the incredible achievement of one of your students, **Sophia Felgate**.

Through her dedication and hard work, Sophia has raised a commendable total of £630 for the British Red Cross. Her efforts are truly inspiring and will have a significant impact on our ongoing efforts to provide vital assistance to those affected by the Ukraine crisis.

To illustrate the impact of Sophia's fundraising, the funds she has raised could be used in the following ways:

- £630 could provide over 75,600 chlorine tablets, enough to ensure that many families have access to clean, safe water during these challenging times.
- Alternatively, it could purchase 3 fully equipped first aider's kits, essential for treating those who are wounded.
- It could also supply 4 generators to keep electricity running at our operational centres or provide 35 hygiene kits for families of five, giving them the supplies to stay healthy for a month.

Sophia's commitment exemplifies the compassion and humanitarian spirit that we at the British Red Cross strive to promote. Her remarkable achievement reflects not only her own character but also the supportive and encouraging environment fostered at Western Primary School.
