The Victorians

What would life have been like for a Victorian child at Western?

Overview of the topic

During this topic, we will have a history focus while we learn about the lives of Victorian people. We will start off by looking at a real photo of children at Western School in 1897. We will experience what it would have been like in a Victorian schoolroom when we spend the day in role on our Victorian day. We will also find out what would have happened to children who could not afford to go to school and lived in the workhouse.

We will explore some of the jobs that Victorian children might have done and find out about the Earl of Shaftesbury, the reforms he made and how this changed children's lives. We will be reading extracts from Cogheart by Peter Bunzl, which is set in an alternative Victorian world.

Science this half term is all about Evolution and Inheritance. In art we will be exploring different printing techniques making links to Victorian artist William Morris.
