Please find below, details of our Bewerley Park trip to enable you to begin collecting some of the items.

Equipment for Bewerley Park Year 4 visit 30th April - 2nd May 2025

Our time at Bewerley Park involves a lot of time outdoors, whatever the weather, and there is a likelihood of clothes getting wet and/or muddy so, hard-wearing, warm clothes are required.

CLOTHES FOR ACTIVITIES (PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING)	
3 pairs thick socks & 3 pairs thinner socks	
3 to 4 long sleeved fleece/hoodie/jumper/warm tops	
3 to 4 trousers (No jeans), tracksuit bottoms or doubled-up leggings are ideal	
Fleece /woollen gloves or mitts, warm hat, scarf/buff/snood	
Waterproof jacket or coat (the children will be provided with a full set of waterproofs when they get to Bewerley but it is nice to have their own jacket)	
3 or 4 warm shirts / T-shirts / thermal tops (avoid cotton).	
2 pairs of trainers - 1 for normal use + 1 old pair for wet activities	
1 pair of walking/outdoor shoes/boots (these can be provided when your child gets to Bewerley so please do not purchase them if you do not have them).	
OTHER ESSENTIALS	<u>USEFUL ITEMS</u>
4/5 changes of underwear	Diary if they want to write
Socks (for when not on activities)	Torch + spare batteries
1 towel (if they want to shower, their choice)	Small rucksack to be used daily
 Medication ready to give to Miss Riddle* See note on the next page. 	Cuddly toy
Plasters for blisters	A book to read at night and playing cards
 Toiletries, etc. * No aerosols please as they set off the smoke alarms. 	• Lypsyl
Sun cream/sunhat/sunglasses	Bin liner for dirty clothes
Drinks Bottle (1 litre)	

Pyjamas or night-clothes and a spare set of

clothes to change into for evenings.

Things we do not want your child to bring:

- *Electronic equipment e.g., phones
- *Food or snacks
- *Toys
- *Anything expensive

Finally, it would be useful if your child has packed his/her bag alongside you so that he/she knows exactly what equipment and clothing they have for each activity.

Medication

Please bring any medication that your child would normally use, for this period of time, into school, on the Wednesday that we leave for Bewerley. Please make sure that all medication is clearly labelled with your child's name, dosage, when to administer etc. All such medication should be handed over to Miss Riddle, who will be on the door, to collect them on the morning of departure.

Day of Departure

On the day of departure, the children need to arrive at <mark>8.45am</code> and they come in their Bewerley clothes. They do not need to come in school uniform. Please try not to over pack for your child as they do have to carry/walk their bags a considerable distance, on arrival.</mark>

Please arrive on time for school as normal and $\frac{bring}{a}$ a packed lunch. Suitcases should be left under the pergola (stage area). We return to school on the Friday at around 2-2.15pm. Please try to be there to pick up your child on time. All they want to see is their parents at the end of the trip for a huge hug. We will send a text message updating the time we will arrive back at school.

We are all excited and looking forward to ensuring that your child has a superb experience at Bewerley Park.
