The workshops designed to help pupils learn new skills and make work they are really proud of. No specific level of skill is required...just enthusiasm! Pupils will be guided throughout, with differentiated methods of teaching to fully support or stretch a range of abilities while enjoying themselves.

Pupils will be working with different kinds of paint, learning how to work with brushes to achieve new techniques, developing drawing skills and working with collage too. Your child will bring home watercolour paintings, acrylic studies and mixed media on canvas. Everything is geared towards pupils feeling a great sense of achievement and having fun while making and creating!

The cost of the 6 week course is £49 (£8.16 per session) which includes all the materials and the work your child will bring home.
